JOB SUMMARY

The Food Service Employee is responsible for the preparation and serving of a variety of food items to students, staff, and visitors in the college's dining hall facility.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

High School Diploma or GED and completion of courses toward a diploma in Culinary Arts.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

Completion of or eligible for completion of a program related certificate along with the minimum qualifications.

- Knowledgeable about methods of students' evaluation.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensures proper food preparation and handling.
- Assists with maintaining procedures for cost, waste, and quality control.
- Assists with responding to stakeholders concerns promptly and respectfully.
- Assists with coordinating all maintenance issues by reporting them to the supervisor.
- Follows proper cash handling and guest credit card procedures.
- Cleans and assists with daily maintenance of the Café to ensure proper health and sanitation compliance.
- Demonstrates the ability to lift 50-75 pounds as well as the ability to stand for 2-3 hour intervals.
- Effectively communicates with all stakeholders.

PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Completes staff development plan requirements each year and enters activity reports into the appropriate reporting systems promptly.
- Maintains certifications required for employment within the food service industry.
