MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS


Three years of technical/hands-on experience in electronics/electrical design, prototyping, testing, or electrical/electromechanical maintenance, or other related engineering discipline.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

Five or more years of industrial experience or applicable laboratory experience. Teaching experience at the K-12 and/or postsecondary level.

MAJOR DUTIES

Under general supervision:

- Assists the course instructor with the day-to-day activities and services of the lab area, including scheduling, lab
 set-up, training students on lab equipment and tools, and management of lab equipment and supplies.
- Ensures that the lab/classroom is clean, safe, and organized, promoting safe lab practices.
- Maintains and files course documents in accordance with the College and program policies and procedures.
- Proctors tests/examinations and provides instructional and/or remediation support under the supervision of the course instructor.
- Conducts periodic inventory of lab resources and assists in requisitioning of lab supplies.
- Helps to update and install lab software for engineering technology applications.
- Performs other duties as assigned by the course lab instructor, the Department Head, and/or the Dean.
- Maintains credentials required for the position and profession.
- Demonstrates respect for students as individuals.
- Other duties as assigned

APPLICATION DEADLINE: The position will remain open until filled. All application packets MUST be completed via the Online Job Center at <u>JobCenter (easyhrweb.com)</u>. As a part of the application process, interested candidates will be required to upload other documents, including a resume, cover letter, and unofficial transcripts (see job center listing for more details).
