A review of completed application packets may begin upon receipt. Interviews of qualified candidates may be held following review; the position may close any time after January 13, 2026 based on candidate selection(s).

Position Summary:

Under general supervision, provides instruction to students in the Paramedicine and EMS programs, prepares syllabi and lesson plans. Develops program goals and objectives. The instructor must possess the ability to teach all phases of the curriculum. Demonstrates the use of appropriate teaching techniques; use of appropriate testing and grading procedures including proper maintenance of grade books and any other record-keeping required; effective use of oral and written communication skills; and knowledge of current in-field procedures. Follows approved course syllabus. Maintains program requirements, attends/completes all professional development training; meet with students and college personnel to discuss students' instructional programs and other issues. Evaluates student progress in attaining goals and objectives. Completes all reports, records and invoices in a timely manner and maintains accurate inventory of all assigned properties. Maintains qualifications for employment as described by the Technical College System of Georgia (TCSG) Policy Manual and accreditation standards. Follows rules and regulations as described by the TCSG Policy Manual and other policies and procedures established by the institution. Position may involve teaching traditional day and/or evening classes or online classes and will require travel within the college's service area and additional travel as needed.

Minimum Qualifications: *Must upload transcripts/certifications which show conferred educational degrees/current certifications and document qualifications in the employment history:*

- Earned Associate degree or higher from an academic institution accredited by an institutional accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (CoAEMSP Standard III.B.6.b.)
- Documented active license as a Georgia EMS Instructor/Coordinator (Paramedic) as listed on the Georgia Department of Public Health Office of EMS and Trauma website: <https://dph.georgia.gov/EMS/ems-licensure/ems-instructor-licensure> **OR** achieve EMS Instructor/Coordinator license within 3 months of hiring.

- Documented active Georgia license as one of the following: Paramedic, Registered Nurse, Physician's Assistant, Physician.
- Documented active BLS Certification.
- Documented minimum of two (2) years clinical experience in the past five (5) years

Preferred Qualifications: *Preference may be given to applicants who, in addition to meeting the minimum qualifications, provide transcripts of conferred degrees and demonstrate in the employment history possession of one or more of the following:*

- Documented teaching experience at the post-secondary level.
- Documented certification in one or more of the following: ACLS Instructor, PHTLS/ITLS Instructor, PALS/EPC instructor, BLS Instructor.
- Documented specialty provider and/or instructor certifications in fire and emergency related specialties

Projected Work Hours/Location:

This position generally works normal business day hours of 7:45 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and 7:45 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Friday. Additional hours or a flexible schedule to include evenings, and/or weekends, may be required as needed. Position will be assigned to the Warner Robins or Macon campus and may require travel to any of the locations within the College's service area, as well as other travel as needed. This position will work all 12 calendar months per year and at 40 hours per week.

Salary / Benefits:

The selected candidate can expect to receive a contingent offer with an annual gross salary of \$56,000 for an Associate's degree and \$59,000 for a Bachelor's degree. Actual annual gross salary to be determined the candidate's highest qualifying degree based on meeting published minimum and preferred qualifications. Position is eligible for state benefits to include retirement, insurance, leave accrual and holiday pay. CGTC is a member of Teachers Retirement System of Georgia (TRS) and Employees Retirement System of Georgia (ERS).

Application Procedure:

Applicants are required to complete the employment application in full and provide supporting documentation by the stated closing deadline for the position. CGTC does not accept mailed, faxed, or hand-delivered applications.

Applicants who complete the application procedure will be evaluated for meeting the position requirements based on the published job responsibilities, meeting the minimum and preferred qualifications based on the educational history, employment skills presented under job duties in the application system against the published job announcement. A completed application packet consists of the following:

1. A completed CGTC electronic application in the CGTC application portal.
2. As applicable, applicants for instructional positions are asked to provide a resume in addition to completing the CGTC application. Applicants for non-instructional positions may provide a resume if they wish. Submission of the resume does not replace the requirement to complete the CGTC electronic application.
3. Postsecondary transcripts that demonstrate the conferral of the degree, if applicable, and

demonstrates the applicant meets the educational minimum requirements and, if applicable, the preferred educational requirements (*grade reports and diploma copies are not accepted in lieu of transcripts*)

4. Positions requiring a High School Diploma or GED as a minimum qualification do not have to submit a HSD/GED transcript documentation as part of the application process
5. Non-photo license(s) and/or certification(s) which fulfill the minimum, and if applicable the preferred qualifications stated in the job announcement

Incomplete application packets at the time of the position closing may not be considered. It is the responsibility of the applicant to obtain and upload the application documentation by the stated deadline.
