

Internship Opportunity

We are looking for an Intern/Adult Learner for Summer 2019 for our "Political Rewind with Bill Nigut" daily radio program.

Georgia Public Broadcasting (GPB) is a network of 18 radio stations and nine television stations. We broadcast to all of Georgia and parts of Florida, Alabama, Tennessee, North Carolina and South Carolina – and reach an even bigger audience through the internet and our <u>podcasts</u>. "Political Rewind with Bill Nigut" is GPB's political radio talk show which airs on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday at 2p, when it also streams live on the GPB News website and on Facebook. In addition, the Friday program airs on GPB television on Friday evenings and Sunday mornings. The show features respectful conversations about Georgia political news as well as national political news through the lens of it's impact on Georgians.

The Intern or Adult Learner will:

- > play an active role in the creative and collaborative process of producing live radio.
- shadow producers and learn how to pitch and research ideas, book guests and produce live and pre-recorded segments.
- receive hands-on experience with web journalism, social media branding and online engagement strategies.

<u>Previous interns</u> have produced <u>show segments</u> and <u>audio pieces</u>, earning producer credits and web bylines to add to their resumes and portfolios.

The Intern or Adult Learner requirements are:

- > a commitment of at least 10 hours per week during typical workday hours
- the ability to research
- > proficiency with Twitter, Facebook and Instagram
- > journalistic, broadcast, creative writing skills
- > a team-centered, collaborative attitude plus self-motivation and a willingness to learn
- > the ability to use Adobe Audition and knowledge of AP style (preferred, not required)
