Job Summary:

Georgia Northwestern Technical College is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Adult Education Integrated Education and Training Early Childhood Instructor to be located on the Whitfield Murray County Campus and will be required to travel to other campuses to meet operational requirements. This position will report to Derrick McDaniel, Director of Instruction. The Adult Education IET Instructor is responsible for providing education and/or training to adult education students enrolled in the Early Childhood IET to include adult basic education (ABE) and English as a second language (ESL) support. The schedule is based on course offerings and would be based on availability between 8:30am to 2:00pm Monday through Thursday with a maximum of 22 hours per week. This position requires an on-campus work environment presence and does not offer a telework option.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Assist with classroom presentations;
- Maintain an effective learning environment;
- Complete documentation of student progress;
- Perform various types of clerical tasks for the Integrated Education and Training program;
- Request and maintain assigned classroom supplies, materials and equipment;
- Assist individual students and/or groups in the learning environment;
- Maintain a secure classroom environment;
- Contact students for retention purposes;
- Proctor assessments; Maintain appropriate test administrator certifications;
- Other duties as assigned.

Competencies:

- Skill in oral and written communication
- Knowledge of various Assessments and allowable materials
- Ability to assist students individually or in groups
- Ability to maintain accurate records
- Ability to prepare lesson materials
- Ability to operate workroom machinery such as copiers, scanners, shredders, etc.

Minimum Qualifications:

The successful candidate will possess an Associate's Degree in Early Childhood or a related field, and have prior classroom management experience in an educational or training setting.

Note: Experience may substitute for the degree on a year-for-year basis

Preferred Qualifications:

The successful candidate will possess a Bachelor's Degree in a related field, and have prior experience assisting in an adult education multi-level classroom.

Physical Demands:

Work is typically performed in a classroom or office environment with intermittent sitting, standing, or walking in various settings. The employee occasionally lifts or moves objects to a light to medium weight. Full range of hand and finger motion may be utilized for data entry purposes.

If the job involves driving, physical requirements include the ability to operate a vehicle and sit for extended periods.

Salary: \$25.00 per hour

Benefits:

If this is a part-time position, no benefits are available. If this is a full-time position, benefits include: 13 paid State holidays, annual and sick leave, paid parental leave, educational support leave, options in the State of Georgia health and flexible benefits package, 401K & 457 options, a choice of two retirement systems dependent upon position: Teachers Retirement System of Georgia or the Employee's Retirement System of Georgia.
