Three years paid work experience in-field within the past seven years. Work experience must include the competencies, skills and knowledge levels included in the Industrial Systems instructional program. Excellent organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills.

Preferred Qualifications: Bachelor Degree in related discipline. Post-Secondary Teaching experience, curriculum development, and program recruitment experience in a two-year college environment. Excellent technology and classroom management skills.
