

Nurse Aid Instructor Full Time Gordon County Campus

Job Summary:

Georgia Northwestern Technical College is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Full Time Instructor in the Accelerated Nurse Aid Program. The home campus for the position is the Gordon County Campus; however, travel to other campuses may be required to meet operational requirements. This position is responsible for the planning, instruction, and advisement in the CNA program. This position will report to the Dean of Nursing and Health Technologies.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Responsible for successfully preparing students for the State approved exam
- Maintain a clean, well-stocked lab for learning experiences.
- Grading of student work
- Record keeping in adherence with state and/federal guidelines for CNA program
- Attend and be responsible for all planned clinical sessions for the students
- The skills must be checked off in the lab setting prior to, "hands on" in the healthcare facility setting
- Other duties assigned

Competencies:

- Knowledge of federal and state regulations for CNA programs
- Able to make decisions affecting student learning
- Good problem-solving skills
- Good verbal, interpersonal relations, and communication skills
- Familiarity with BlackBoard LMS and computer skills
- Understanding of diversity, equity and inclusivity as well as social determinants of health required
- Validate student's log-in/log-out, assignments, quizzes/exams
- Follow the daily approved lesson plan curriculum and hours as approved by the State of Georgia

Minimum Qualifications:

RN or LPN with current License in good standing. One year of nursing experience. Must have completed a course in teaching adults or have experience in teaching adults and/or supervising nurse aides.

Preferred Qualifications:

BSN. Post-secondary teaching experience. Train the Trainer Certification from Alliant Health Solutions.

Physical Demands:

Work is typically performed in a classroom or office environment with intermittent sitting, standing, or walking in various settings. The employee occasionally lifts or moves objects to a light to medium weight. Full range of hand and finger motion may be utilized for data entry purposes.

If the job involves driving, physical requirements include the ability to operate a vehicle and sit for extended periods.

Salary: LPN: \$60,000; ASN: \$64,480; BSN: \$70,000

Benefits:

If this is a part-time position, no benefits are available. If this is a full-time position, benefits include: 13 paid State holidays, annual and sick leave, paid parental leave, educational support leave, options in the State of Georgia health and flexible benefits package, 401K & 457 options, a choice of two retirement systems dependent upon position: Teachers Retirement System of Georgia or the Employee's Retirement System of Georgia.
