### **Associate of Science Nursing Instructor (VLD)**

This position is a full time faculty position in an Associate of Science in Nursing Program. The instructor shall primarily be responsible for instructional preparation and teaching nursing courses at the Associate of Science in nursing degree level in the classroom, clinical and laboratory settings. The instructor will prepare lesson plans for classroom instruction, labs and clinical experiences, assist with developing program curriculum, syllabi, goals, and objectives, advise students and evaluate students' progress in attaining goals and objectives. The instructor will assist with and maintain program certification/accreditation requirements as appropriate, and assist with recruitment, retention, and job placement efforts. Position may include variable hours, including weekend clinical supervision of students. Requirements include ensuring a safe and healthy work environment by complying with college health and safety policies, standard practices in maintaining occupational health and safety legislation and regulations.
