Culinary Arts Instructor (VLD and Local High Schools)

Under general supervision, will provide instruction to students in Culinary Arts courses. Demonstrates the use of appropriate teaching techniques. Demonstrates ability to order products and maintain appropriate inventory. Demonstrates the effective use of oral and written communication skills. Demonstrates knowledge of current safety/culinary procedures in the field. Demonstrates the use of appropriate testing and grading procedures including proper maintenance of grade books and any other appropriate record-keeping required. Follows approved course syllabus. Completes all reports, records and invoices in a timely manner and maintains an accurate inventory of all assigned properties. Courses will be taught primarily at local area high schools (Brooks, Lowndes, Valdosta, Cooks, etc...).

Position may include variable hours, including weekend clinical supervision of students. Requirements include ensuring a safe and healthy work environment by complying with college health and safety policies, standard practices in maintaining occupational health and safety legislation and regulations.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Associate degree in culinary arts or closely related field. ServeSafe Manager Certification. At least 3 of the last 7 years must be employed in field. Strong written and verbal communication skills. Excellent interpersonal and teamwork skills and experience using Microsoft Office software.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

Bachelors degree in culinary arts or closely related field. Experience teaching at the post-secondary level is preferred. Experience as a baking/pastry chef is preferred. Registered dietitian or licensed dietitian and/or background in nutrition, healthcare, and/or foodservice is preferred.

Salary is \$40,000. This is a full time position with standard State of GA benefits.
